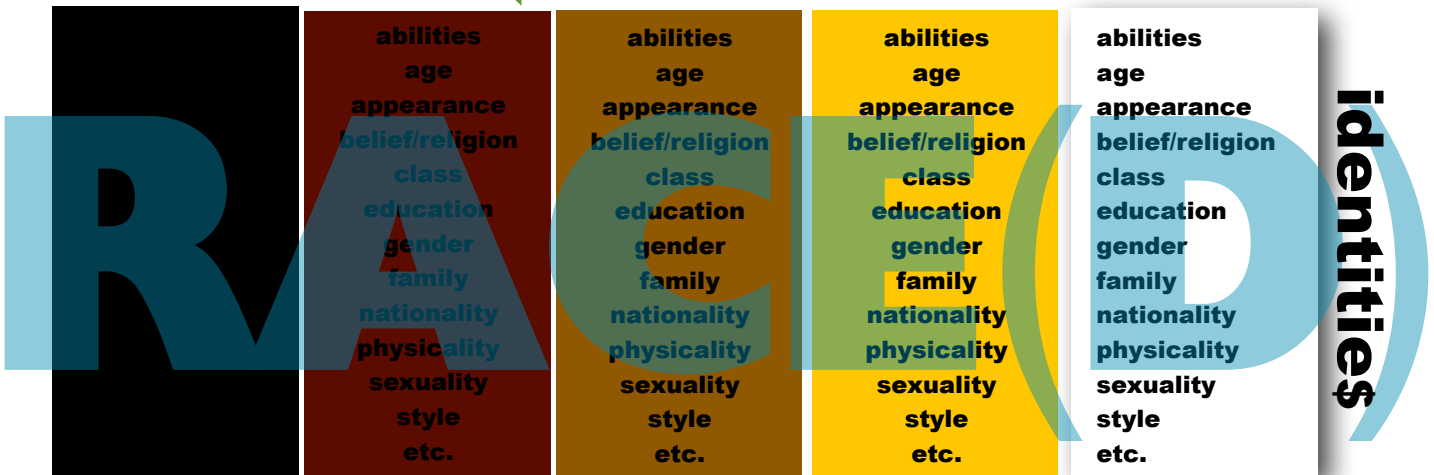


# Race intersects with every identity all the time every time...
